DAY ONE, FALL 2011

- Arrive Logan International Airport (*BOS*) mid to late afternoon from Oregon and meet your Group Tour Company escort/guide and motorcoach both of whom will be with you for the next eight days
- Direct transfer to your hotel
- Welcome dinner

DAY TWO, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Plymouth with Plymouth Rock and the Mayflower II
- Plimoth Plantation
- Lunch
- Boston's Freedom Trail with Boston Common, the Massachusetts State House, Old South Meeting House, Faneuil Hall, Paul Revere House, and Old North Church
- Dinner at Quincy Market
- The Prudential Building Sky Walk

DAY THREE, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Lexington and Concord with sightseeing in the Minuteman National Historical Park
- Picnic lunch
- Drive to Salem, MA (*20 miles/30 minutes*)
- The Salem Witch Museum and House of Seven Gables (*if time allows you may wish to consider a visit to the Peabody Essex Museum*)
- Depart Salem for Gloucester, MA (*20 miles/30 minutes*)
- Traditional Lobster Bake Dinner on the harbor
- Return to Boston and your hotel following dinner

DAY FOUR, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel followed by check out
- Depart Boston for Lake Winnepesaukee (*100 miles/ 2 hours*)
- Lunch cruise on the lake
- The Kancamagus Scenic Highway in route to North Conway, NH (*90 miles/2.5 hours*)
- Check in suggested hotel
- Dinner this evening in quaint downtown North Conway

DAY FIVE, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel followed by check out
- Depart North Conway for Franconia, NH (*50 miles/ 1 hour*)
- Franconia Notch and the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway
- Continue onto St. Johnsbury, VT with a visit to the Maple Museum (*30 miles, 45 minutes*)
- Lunch
- Continue west through the Quechee Gorge and Woodstock into Rutland, VT (*105 miles/ 2.5 hours*)
- Check in suggested hotel
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

DAY SIX, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Depart Rutland with scenic sightseeing in route north to Shelburne, VT
- The Shelburne Museum (*80 miles/1.5 hours*)
- Lunch
- Depart Shelburne for Ticonderoga, NY (*40 miles/1.5 hours*)
- Fort Ticonderoga
- Late afternoon return to Rutland (*50 miles/1 hour*)
- Dinner this evening in Rutland

- Depart Rutland for Sturbridge, MA (*175 miles/4.5 hours*)
- Stop Manchester, VT (*1 hour*) and a visit to Hildene, Todd Lincoln's home
- Continue south to Bennington, VT (*30 minutes*) with The Bennington Museum and Grandma Moses collection
- Lunch
- Continue south to Stockbridge, MA (*1.5 hours*) and a visit to the Norman Rockwell Museum
- Continue west stopping in Sturbridge, MA (*1.5 hours*)
- Check suggested hotel
- Dinner

DAY EIGHT, FALL 2011

- Breakfast at the hotel followed by hotel check out
- Sturbridge Village
- Lunch
- Depart Sturbridge for Boston (*60 miles/1.5 hours*) and your departure flight home from Logan International Airport (*BOS*)
