Rock Hall Annex in New York Is Closing

[The New York City annex](#) of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame will close on Jan. 3, The Associated Press reported. The A.P. cited a news release by S2BN Entertainment, a partner in the venture, which gave no reason for the closing. In an interview with The Cleveland Plain Dealer, Terry Stewart, the chief executive of the Hall of Fame, said the decision to close the annex at 76 Mercer Street in SoHo was made by its corporate partners.
